

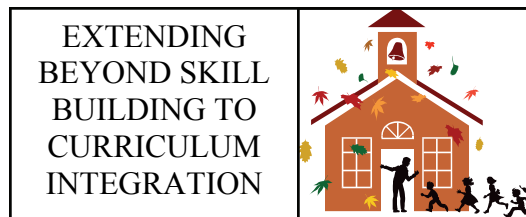

### Advanced Blogging.....July 29-30

- Participants must take Beginning Blogging or have background knowledge of Blogger software
- Investigate video blogging (vlogging)
- Explore advanced formatting, widgets, feeds, and other tools

### Flash Animation.....August 3 & 5

- Explore the Flash environment
- Work with animation techniques
- Create and publish an animation

### Virtual Learning Academy .....August 13 TEACHER TRAINING

- Learn how to use Twitter to communicate with students and parents
  - Set up and customize a Twitter account
  - Learn to use hashtags, auto tweeting, twitpics, and URL shortening

- Learn to use Facebook safely and professionally with students and parents
  - Create a Facebook teacher page & class page
  - Connect with other educators for professional growth

#### Classroom Podcasting & Video

Thursday, May 12, 2011 (4:30 – 7:00 p.m.) at OUE  
\*\*You must attend both sessions to receive credit.  
\*\*You must bring a headphone/microphone set to these sessions.
- Create podcasts for and with students
  - Create video for and with students
  - Learn how and where to share podcasts and videos

The main goal of each session will be to familiarize users with practical applications of the tools with students.
